Scheduling: Workshops B & C can be booked either as 3 single lessons, or as one double plus a single lesson.

Requirements: School to provide laptop computer, data projector and whiteboard.

Maximum class numbers

To maximize the level of effective interaction among students and ensure there is a sufficient allocation of resources for group activities, the maximum number of students per class should **not exceed 30**. However, additional student numbers may be negotiated with Kidz Biz Education beforehand.
