They also work well as an introduction to school-based programs in Pastoral Care and Personal Development.

#### Supplementary/Additional workshops available:

In addition to the core lessons provided, as indicated in the above table, three supplementary workshops are offered as well.

#### **Workshop E: Friendships, Conflict and Stress**

A session that equips students with a survival kit of skills required to build /make successful, healthy, friendships/relationships, as well as strategies for resilience, coping with stress and conflict. Mission Australia (2021) surveyed 30,000 young people between the ages of 11 and 24 years. Two of the highest ranked issues that worried them, were family conflict and coping with stress.

#### Workshop F: Respectful relationships, overexposed & under prepared

A session looking at what it means to have consenting, healthy and respectful relationships. Current research is showing that children who view inappropriate online (including violent and/or pornographic) material are at risk of harm to their psychological development and mental health at a critical time in their development. The younger the age of first exposure, the more profound these effects can be in shaping who a child becomes as an adult.

Sex offences by school-aged children have quadrupled in Australia in only four years.

#### Workshop G: Internet safety, social media, sexting

This session helps students identify and develop skills that are required for their online safety. It relates to the importance of maintaining respectful relationships and practicing consent when using social media. It also looks at what 'sexting' is and helps students understand the legal consequences of this practice.

Note: The above core and optional workshops can be tailored in accordance with the school ethos and gender requirements for both public and private schools.

#### **Maximum class numbers**

To maximize the level of effective interaction among students and ensure there is a sufficient allocation of resources for group activities, the maximum number of students per class should **not exceed 32**. However, additional student numbers may be negotiated with Kidz Biz Education beforehand.
