



'Overexposed & Under-Prepared'

What **parents, grandparents, carers and guardians** of young people need to know about current **'porn culture'**

Exploring how exposure to explicit imagery and messaging impacts on young people's well being is an issue we can't afford to ignore.

Current research is showing that children who view pornographic material are at risk of harm to their psychological development and mental health at a critical time in their development.

Pornography production, dissemination and consumption are at record levels and growing.

- 30% of all internet traffic is porn-related
- Single largest group of porn consumers are 12-17 year olds
- The average first age of exposure to pornography is 10 years

Sex offences by school-aged children have quadrupled in Australia in only four years.

Wendy Hill from **Kidz Biz Education** is offering information workshops to South Australian schools, **'Overexposed & Under-Prepared'**, which explores the impact that exposure to explicit imagery has on young people. The presentation also gives suggestions on how adults with children in their care can respond and address the problems that 'porn' consumption' and exposure creates.
