



## 'Overexposed & Under-Prepared'

### What teachers need to know about current 'porn culture'

Pornography has become the most significant sex educator for many young people and it is **NOT** going to go away. In order to assist young people to navigate this new reality, schools, parents and community organizations must address the issues.

Current research is showing that children who view sexually explicit material are at risk of harm to their psychological development and mental health at a critical time in their development.

Sex offences by school-aged children have quadrupled in Australia in only four years.

In a national study published in the *Journal of Sex Education* (28<sup>th</sup> July 2017), a sample of **107 primary school teachers** who taught children aged 5-13 were surveyed, **40 percent** of teachers said they had **observed problematic sexual behavior**.

Support your school to deliver sexuality education for the 21<sup>st</sup> century, where students learn to critique porn's influences and aspire to something better.
